3D: Deciphering Diagnostic Dilemmas

The contemporary but comprehensive knowledge regarding CBCT and its proper application, guides the practitioner in improving diagnostic purposes and treatment planning. It has been observed that the exposure from CBCT is within the same range as traditional dental imaging and moreover, a complete series of traditional dental radiographs has a higher radiation dose than CBCT, hence justifying the ALADA principle. There is strong evidence to suggest that CBCT imaging could replace conventional 2D imaging. It should be balanced with the perspective that most CBCT studies are easier to perform in a dental office when compared with a full-mouth series of radiographs, or perhaps even a panoramic radiograph with bitewings—and selected periapical images. This presentation focuses on the various applications of CBCT in dentistry.
