CDE Program on Antibiotic Stewardship - In association with IDA, KSB and IAPHD, Kerala - 19th June 2025





In a significant initiative aimed at promoting responsible antibiotic use and combating antimicrobial resistance, IDA Kochi, in association with IDA Kerala State and the Indian Association of Public Health Dentistry (IAPHD), Kerala Chapter, organized a highly informative Continuing Dental Education (CDE) program, on 19th June 2025, in observance of the National Public Health Dentistry Day 2025

The program, centered around "Antibiotic Smart Antibiotic Initiatives," brought together leading experts to shed light on this critical public health issue for dental practitioners.

The CDE program featured two insightful sessions delivered by distinguished speakers. The first session, focusing on "Antibiotic Smart Antibiotic Initiatives by IDA KSB," was presented by Dr. Deebu J Mathew, Nodal Officer for Dental Antibiotic Stewardship, KARSAP (Kerala Antimicrobial Resistance Strategic Action Plan). His presentation provided a comprehensive overview of the state-level initiatives undertaken to promote judicious antibiotic prescribing practices among dental professionals, highlighting the vital role dentists play in the broader fight against antibiotic resistance.

Following this, Dr. Deepti Simon, Professor and Head of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Government Dental College, Alappuzha, delivered an engaging session on "Antibiotic Stewardship by Dental Surgeons - The Way Forward." She elaborated on practical strategies and best practices that dental surgeons can adopt in their daily clinical routines to ensure effective antibiotic stewardship. Her talk emphasized the importance of evidence-based decision-making, proper diagnosis, and patient education in minimizing unnecessary antibiotic prescriptions.

The program was well-attended by members of IDA Kochi and other dental professionals, reflecting the growing awareness and commitment within the dental fraternity to address the challenge of antimicrobial resistance.
